ORDINANCE NO. 123

THE VILLAGE OF BARAGA ORDAINS:

Any person or persons owning or having in possession or control of any reptiles, fowl, rodents, bees, or animals within the Village Limits of the Village of Baraga, shall keep and maintain the same confined or enclosed upon or within the premises and shall prohibit the same from disturbing the public. Failure to do so is hereby declared a public nuisance punishable by not to exceed a \$100.00 fine or 90 days in jail, or both such fine and imprisonment.






