

ORDINANCE # 174 AND #175

VILLAGE OF BARAGA CURFEW/PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY ORDINANCE

CURFEW FOR MINORS: #174

No minor under the age of seventeen (17) years shall loiter, wander, stroll, or play upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, public buildings, places of amusement, vacant lots, or other unsupervised places between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM of the following day, official time; provided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply to a minor accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Any minor violating the provisions of this paragraph shall be deemed to be delinquent, and may be complained against in the Probate Court for the County of Baraga as a delinquent child by police officers.

PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY: #175

No parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor child under the age of seventeen (17) years shall permit such minor to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, or play in or on the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots, or other unsupervised places, between the hours of 10:00 PM and 7:00 AM the following day, official time; provided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply when the minor is accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having care and custody of the minor, or unless the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Every parent, guardian or adult who is convicted of a violation of this section shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days or by a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500.00) or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. Each violation of the provisions of this section shall constitute a separate offense.


