

ORDINANCE 252
MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS

Effective August 8, 2019

An Ordinance to adopt Ordinance 252, Marihuana Establishments, of the Code of the Village of Baraga.

THE VILLAGE OF BARAGA ORDAINS:

INTENT.

The Intent of this Ordinance is to exercise the Village of Baraga's authority to prohibit the establishment or operation of marihuana establishment with in the Village as such facilities are defined in the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act (the "Act").

PROHIBITION.

Pursuant to the Act, Section 6.1, the Village prohibits the establishment or operation of any and all categories of marihuana establishments within its boundaries.

EFFECTIVE DATE.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately due to protect public health, safety, welfare, and the orderly administration of the affairs of the Village of Baraga.

Any ordinance or parts of any ordinance in conflict with any provision of these ordinances are hereby repealed. The ordinance shall become effective upon 30 days from publication by the Village Clerk.

This ordinance shall be published by posting the same in three (3) public sights, Village of Baraga Hall, 100 Hemlock St, The L'Anse Sentinel and the Village of Baraga web site.
